

My Voting Plan

1. Verify Your SC Registration Record

- I am registered to vote.
- I have verified that my SC voter record is valid and my registration address matches my state ID by going to www.scvotes.gov/voters and selecting “Check Your Voter Registration”. After entering your information, the next screen should say “Registered & Ready to Vote.”

2. Choose how I will vote

- I will vote in person during early voting time, Tuesday May 26, 2026 – Friday June 5, 2026, 8:30 AM – 5:00 PM (excluding weekends)
- I will vote in person on Primary Election Day (Tuesday, June 9, 2026) 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM
- I will vote by absentee ballot. I requested my ballot on _____ & returned it on _____

3. I will prepare to vote

- I know my polling location. (Note: Some locations have changed since you last voted)
 - If voting early, early voting locations are listed on the back of this sheet
 - If voting on Election Day, I have verified my polling location as shown on back of this sheet
- I have downloaded my sample ballot by scanning this QR code or by going to www.scvotes.gov/voters and under MyscVOTES, select “Get My Sample Ballot” so I will know where I vote and who and what is on my ballot. Because this is a primary election where you are choosing a representative for a party, you must select which party’s election you wish to participate in before you can view your sample ballot.
- I have researched my candidates.
- I have researched any advisory questions on my ballot (only on Republican ballot).

If you vote on election day, you must vote at your assigned voting location, some which have changed. Go to www.scvotes.gov/voters. Scroll down to the "MyscVOTES" section to "Find My Polling Place" and complete the form to determine your location.

WHAT IDS CAN I USE?

Driver's license, DMV issued ID card (available free from the DMV), Photo Voter Registration Card, Federal military ID, or U.S. passport.

If you cannot get a photo ID due to a reason beyond your control, you may vote a provisional ballot after presenting a current, non-photo registration card and signing an affidavit provided by poll managers stating why you could not obtain the photo ID. Your ballot will count unless your reason is challenged and denied.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

If you are already in the line by the 7 pm closing time, you are supposed to still be allowed to vote.
